Conversations to Have with Your Hospice Team


Medication Side Effects



Each medication that one takes has a side effect. Sometimes, these medications are necessary during the hospice process. Some medications will make you sleepy. Some medications will upset your stomach. Some medications will cause constipation. The team can solve these issues. As a hospice team, we want to make sure you ALWAYS have the training you need so please let your nurses, social workers, spiritual counselor, home health aide know if you are experience any of the side effects or have any questions.
